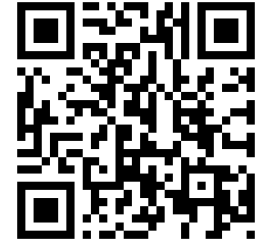

**FOCUS FROM PREVIOUS UNITS OF STUDY:**

Explain how Great Britain imposed economic and political control over the colonies.

1. Describe the economic and religious reasons 6 English colonies were founded
2. Explain how the geography and climate of each colonial region influenced how it developed.
3. Explain how each colonial region was interdependent on the others.
4. How was social and political life different in the 3 colonial regions?
5. Describe the process by which people indentured themselves to go to the colonies and what their lives were like.
6. Explain the similarities and differences in the lives of free and enslaved African Americans in the colonies.
7. What would you have like and disliked if you were a woman in colonial America?
8. Explain how the French and Indian War changed Great Britain's attitudes about economic and political control of the colonies.
